Banca d'Italia, the Bank of England and Banque de France are jointly organising the 12th edition of their International Macroeconomics Workshop on **13 November 2026**. The **keynote lecture will be given by Oleg Itskhoki (Harvard University)**. The workshop will take place in London at the **Bank of England**.

This edition focuses on **New Risks in International Macro and Finance**. We invite theoretical and empirical research covering the following topics:

- Global imbalances, domestic macro drivers and the role of trade and industrial policies
- Geopolitics and the international transmission of commodity shocks
- The future of the international financial system and digital currencies
- Dominant currencies and safe assets in a more fragmented world
- The international spillovers of AI expansion: asset valuations and trade in capital goods and digital services
- Cross-border dimensions of rising sovereign risks
